OUR MISSION STATEMENT AND PHILOSOPHY

Klahhane Gymnastics is dedicated to quality instruction while promoting self-esteem and confidence for each student through participation in and enjoyment of The Ninja Zone. Klahhane is committed to providing an environment that is fun, safe and professional, but also captures the joy of childhood and the satisfaction of learning and achievement.

Klahhane Ninja Trainers use drills that introduce the Ninja skills in smaller, more achievable goals. Strength and flexibility challenges are presented as well as games and safety drills. Our Li'l Ninja and Ninja curriculum develops coordination for all sports as well as introducing the basic Ninja skills. Children will experience a variety of challenges in order to develop basic motor skills, strength and flexibility while they learn focus and discipline and following multiple instructions.

KLAHHANE GENERAL PROCEDURES & INFORMATION:

OBSERVATION: Spectators are welcome on the upper mezzanine! Due to fire regulations please refrain from standing along the lower railing or sitting on the stairs. Coaching or calling out to your child from the sidelines is distracting for the students. Cheers and smiles are welcomed. Please keep siblings with you and under your direct supervision at all times. Children in the waiting area are welcome to use the books and videos provided.

CLASS ATTIRE: Ninja's will order their Ninja Uniform (T-shirt and headband) directly from the Ninja Zone website. <http://theninjazone.store> This will be worn to all classes with any elastic waist athletic shorts of your choice. Ninjas may purchase and use our local Ninja shirt as an alternate uniform. Ninja grip socks available from the website are optional. Please bring your Ninja water bottle or a personal one of similar type with a flip or pull cap filled with plain water only to every class. Students who forget their water bottle may borrow one from the "clean" box" and return it to the "used" box at the end of class.

CLASS SCHEDULING & SIZE: Student teacher ratio for all Ninja classes is 1:6. If enrollment drops to 3 or less those students may be integrated into another class if space permits. If only one student shows up for any class the student will be integrated into another class at the same time for that day only.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Students are expected to arrive on time in order to participate in all activities. Students must not be dropped off more than 10 minutes prior to their class time and must be picked up within 10 minutes of class ending time. Parents who repeatedly do not pick up their children within 10 minutes after their class ends will be charged a supervision fee.

HOLIDAYS AND CLOSURES: School year classes for 2018-19 are Sept. 14th through June 7th. 2019 Summer Classes dates will be announced in the spring. Klahhane will be closed on the following dates: Thanksgiving Week, Nov. 19-24th; Winter Break Dec. 24th – Jan. 4th; Spring Break March 30 – April 6; Memorial Day May 24-27th. Please see our tuition calendar for tuition blocks.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY: For the safety of students and staff, if the Port Angeles School District schools are closed, Klahhane morning classes are automatically cancelled. Afternoon and evening classes MAY be held if the weather moderates during the day. Announcements will be made on Radio KONP and a message will be placed on the gym phone. Announcements for Saturday closures will be on KONP and the gym phone. Please check to be sure we are open before coming to the gym during severe weather.

KLAHHANE NINJA RULES: (Please review these expectations with your child)

RULE#1: ALWAYS FOLLOW THE NINJA CREED (This is a part of every lesson)

Rule #2: LISTEN AND DO. Listen to your trainer and do what they ask you to do. We expect respectful behavior and sincere effort to follow directions. "Time-outs" will be used for repeated mis-behavior. Continuing incidents may require a parent conference.

Rule #3: NO RUNNING AWAY. Students must stay with their group and coach at all times.

Rule #4: ALWAYS STAND, NEVER SIT.

Rule #5: BE POLITE. Take turns, hands and feet to your self and only kind, helpful comments please.

KLAHHANE NINJA ZONE ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES & PAYMENT INFORMATION:

ENROLLMENT: Classes are on rolling enrollment during the school year. Students may enroll at any time. Tuition is based on four week tuition blocks with payments due monthly at the first class of the tuition block or by the 10th of the month. Tuition is pro-rated for the initial enrollment block only. Once enrolled, class space is reserved for your child and you are responsible for payment of the monthly tuition. **It is your responsibility to notify the office if your child will not be returning for the next tuition period. Failure to notify the office by the 3rd lesson of the current tuition period will result in a charge of 50% tuition for the next tuition period.**

TUITION INFORMATION AND PAYMENT

The Klahhane class schedule is based on the Port Angeles School District school year calendar. Although most months have four weeks, some months are slightly longer. Our tuition periods always cover a four week period. Some tuition periods overlap the previous or following month as illustrated by our tuition calendar, but monthly tuition remains the same. **Tuition is due at the 1st scheduled class of each tuition period regardless of attendance.** A payment grace period extends through the 2nd class of the tuition period. Payments are expected on time unless special arrangements are made. **Ninja's whose accounts are not paid by the 2nd class will be un-enrolled. If there is a class wait list the Ninja will be placed at the end of the list and waiting Ninjas will be notified of the opening in order. If the place is not filled, the Ninja Parent will be notified that they will need to come in and pay the balance due plus a \$5 re-instatement fee to re-instate their child in class.** Tuition is not refundable and is not pro-rated for personal absences. **There are no make-up classes.**

MEMBERSHIP FEE: A non-refundable / non-transferable annual membership fee (\$40) is required of all students. This fee is valid Sept. 1-Aug. 31 each year regardless of the date of enrollment. The registration fee includes secondary medical insurance, discounts on Ninja Birthday Parties and a free T-shirt at the end of year Ninja Celebration.

Debit/credit cards are not accepted for month to month tuition payment or pro shop purchases

Ninja's may enroll in our 3 month renewable **credit card** auto-pay contract plan and receive a discount over the month to month tuition rates.

Enrollment or Transfers between the Monthly and 3 Month Contract Plan are available only in September, December and March.

COUPONS AND DISCOUNTS: Coupons must be presented at time of payment. Discounts and credits cannot be combined or credited after payment.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS: An account will be considered delinquent if more than one month's tuition is due. Please contact the director if you need to arrange a special payment plan. Unless contact and payment arrangements are made delinquent accounts will be sent to a collection agency. Klahhane does not negotiate rates or provide financial aid for Ninja classes.

NSF CHECKS: NSF checks will be re-deposited. If the check is returned again a \$20 return fee will be charged. Unpaid accounts will be turned over to collections if they exceed 2 months tuition. All collection charges will be added to the amount due.

Klahhane Gymnastics is a tobacco, alcohol and drug-free facility. Service animals only, no pets please. All food and drink except plain non-colored water in personal non-spill water bottles, must be consumed in the office area or on the mezzanine.
